NCPGA Foundation: JIM LANGLEY SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Northern California PGA Foundation is pleased to remember and honor Jim Langley, PGA, and his dedication to the game of golf. Jim's outstanding character as a role model for all PGA Professionals, his humble beginnings, and his legendary status as Head Pro at Cypress Point for more than thirty years, led to the establishment of the Jim Langley Scholarship in 2009. The NCPGA Foundation provides financial support to Special Olympics Northern California, Saving Strokes, Meals on Wheels of Monterey, and many other golf programs in addition to the scholarship program.

Purpose and Amount

The scholarship seeks to recognize the outstanding academic and personal accomplishments of High School graduates who are seeking a career through secondary education which possess the fundamental values that the great game of golf has to offer. The award is to help pay for college expenses, including tuition, fees, books or supplies.

The scholarship is made up of two equal awards of \$2,000.00, each to a deserving male and female recipient.

Eligibility

To be eligible, an applicant must:

- Be a graduating high school senior
- Reside within the boundaries of the Northern California PGA Section
- Participate in minimum of six tournaments per year
- Have applied and been accepted at an accredited college or university
- Hold a grade point average minimum of 2.0

Evaluation criteria are based on the following categories: Character, Financial Aid, Academics, Junior Golf Participation, and Other Activities or Community Service.

Selection

The Selection Committee will review applications from all eligible candidates. Finalists will be selected on how well they meet the scholarship criteria.

Award

The scholarship will be issued in the form of a one-time payment directly to the recipient.

How to Apply

Submit a complete application package by the specified due date. Use the following application package checklist to make sure your application package is complete:

- Transcript of your grades and your highest SAT scores in all categories
- Summary of employment history
- Summary of your community and school activities, including offices held and responsibilities
- Short video with you describing your favorite golf experience and the role golf has played in your school and outside activities - Video must be placed on easily accessible website such as YouTube or Facebook
- Three personal letters of reference from adults other than relatives – at least one must be from a local PGA Professional
