## FOUNDATION GRANT GUIDELINE & APPLICATION

Thank you for your interest in Northern California PGA Foundation. The following will provide you with a brief introduction to our organization, and guidelines for our grant program.

### **About the Northern California Section PGA Foundation**

The Northern California PGA Foundation was incorporated in 2007, as the charitable arm of the PGA Northern California Section; a 501c3, non-profit organization, Federal Tax ID#75-3249593. *The mission of the Northern California PGA Foundation is three-fold: To serve Veterans - their health and their families; to provide resources to PGA members serving their communities in Northern California & Northwestern Nevada; and to grow the game of golf.*

### **Funding Considerations and Eligibility**

The NCPGA Foundation issues grants, *up to \$1,250*, to programs that meet our mission statement and make a positive difference and impact for good in our communities. The grant should support direct program needs and not endowment funds. The application must be submitted by an NCPGA Class A Member in good standing.

### ***To be considered, a grant request must be for a Golf Program that serves:***

- a. Veterans
- b. Juniors/Kids
- c. Underserved
- d. Women or Minorities
- e. Disabled

In evaluating the applications, the NCPGA Foundation Fund Giving Committee will consider the following:

- Is the program focused and able to provide a direct impact to improve the lives of others?
- Does the program have clearly defined goals, action plans, and measurable outcomes?
- Will the grant award be used efficiently? How little of the financial support will be used for overhead costs, and how much will be used for direct program needs?
- Has the Applicant ever contributed to the NCPGA Foundation’s fundraising efforts?
- Does the grant impact player development (Golf 2.0/Growth of the Game)?

Support will not be granted for:

- Political causes.
- Programs or organizations that unfairly discriminate against people because of their gender, race, creed, national origin, age, disability or ethnicity.
- Supporting any non-program related costs.
- Paying for green fees or cart fees other than program related.

- List of Board of Directors or leaders for your golf program.

*Please submit a copy of each of the items above. Please submit the complete application and checklist items. If any of the items above are not submitted, your application will be considered incomplete, and review of the application will be delayed or declined.*
